

List of Documents to be Uploaded while Applying for NIRMAN 2026

Clearly legible scanned copies of the following documents are required to be uploaded at the time of submission of application for NIRMAN 2026:

1. Recent Passport Size Colour Photograph: The photograph must match the photograph submitted in the UPSC Civil Services/Forest Services Preliminary Examination 2026 application form/admit card.

2. Scanned Signature on Plain Paper: The signature must be in black or blue ink and must match the signature in the UPSC Civil Services/Forest Services Preliminary Examination 2026 application form/admit card.

3. UPSC Application Form: Complete application form submitted to UPSC for the Civil Services/Forest Services Preliminary Examination 2026.

4. UPSC Admit Card: Admit card issued by UPSC for the Civil Services/Forest Services Preliminary Examination 2026.

5. Valid Photo Identity Proof: Any one of the following: Aadhaar Card / PAN Card / Voter ID Card / Passport / Driving Licence.

6. Bank Account Details: Any one of the following:

- [Bank Mandate Form](#) in CIL format certified by the bank
- Cancelled cheque of the applicant's bank account
- First page of bank passbook containing account details

7. Residency Certificate: Certificate in Government format issued by the competent authority. In the absence of such a certificate, the prescribed [CIL format](#) bearing the signature and seal of the competent authority shall be accepted.

8. Family Income Certificate: Certificate in Government format issued by the competent authority. The certificate must explicitly state that it is for **family income for Financial Year 2025–26**. In the absence of such a certificate, the prescribed [CIL format](#) bearing the signature and seal of the competent authority shall be accepted.

All documents listed above are mandatory. Clarifications, if any, shall be sought only once. Failure to submit any of the required documents may result in rejection of the application. The decision of Coal India Limited in this regard shall be final and binding.
